Code of Conduct

To achieve our goal of creating a fun, safe and healthy atmosphere where every swimmer can work to accomplish their team and individual goals, all club members (coaches, swimmers & parents) agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct.

As a Dolphin I will:

- Support, encourage, and treat all members of the club (coaches, swimmers, parents & facility personnel) with respect and kindness
- Ensure that the Daily Health Check is completed and submitted at least two hours prior to practice
- Ensure that I have read and understand the Covid Safety Plan
- Attend the Covid Safety Meeting at the beginning of the season
- Use appropriate language, be polite and courteous at all times
- Remember that my behavior reflects on the entire Club
- **Promise to attend all MANDATORY Meets**
- Listen to, follow the directions of and show respect for coaches at all times
- Exhibit sportsmanlike behavior at all competitions – congratulate other athletes and respect their performances
- Follow the rules of facilities we practice in or compete at, clean up belongings, and act respectfully towards employees and patrons.

Signature

As a Dolphin Parent I will:

- Notify the club if my child has previously done artistic swimming with another club
- Ensure that the Daily Health Check is completed and submitted at least two hours prior to practice
- Ensure that I have read and understand the Covid Safety Plan
- Attend the Covid Safety Meeting at the beginning of the season
- Ensure my swimmer arrives and leaves practices and meets on time, making sure they have all of the necessary equipment
- Support, encourage, and treat all members of the club (coaches, swimmers, other parents & facility personnel) with respect and kindness
- Refrain from talking to the coach about my child or any other issue while the coach is either preparing for or coaching swimmers
- Speak to my child's coach first if I have an issue of concern and then turn to head coach if my concern has not been met to my satisfaction
- **Promise to ensure swimmer attends all MANDATORY Meets**
- Use appropriate language, be polite and courteous at all times
- Remember that my behavior reflects on the entire club and model sportsmanship behavior at all competitions – congratulate other athletes, respect their performance and hard work and applaud for every routine
- Follow the rules of facilities we practice in or compete in, help swimmer clean up belongings and act respectfully towards employees and patrons
- For competitive parents:
 - Accompany my child to out of town meets or send a family member in my place
 - Pay the BC Artistic Swimming cancellation fees that will be incurred to the Club if for any reason (health-related or otherwise) my child does not attend a meet. I will be aware that this decision will impact the team that they are swimming with, the coaches and Club.
